

**WET PANTS SAILING ASSOCIATION INVITAIONAL REGATTA
JULY 17, 2010**

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2010 (RSS), the US sailing Prescriptions and the Sailing instructions.

2. Eligibility

Skippers and crews should be, but do not have to be members of a GSBYRA affiliated organization.

The following classes are invited to participate: Flying Scot, JY15, Club 420s, Sunfish, and Narrasketuck.

There will be no entry fee

3. Schedule of Events

Registration will be from 0800 to 0900. Complimentary coffee, juice and donuts.

Competitors meeting at 0930

First warning at 10:30

There will be no break for lunch, bottled water will be available on the water. After the racing, there will be complimentary barbeque and awards back at Port-O-Call.

4. Sailing instructions

The sailing instructions will be available on the Wet Pants Sailing Association web site and in printed form on the day of racing.

5. Classes and Courses

Sunfish and JY15's will race on course "A"

Flying Scotts and Tucks will race on course "B"

Courses "A" and "B" will be located south of the Port-O-Call dock and west of Brown's River

6. Schedule of Races

- Course "A"- Seven races will be scheduled - the completion of three races will constitute a regatta. No race will start after 1500
- Course "B- Five races will be scheduled - the completion of three races will constitute a regatta. No race will start after 1500

Note: For the purpose of scoring the first leg of the Long Island Flying Scot Championship, only the scores from the first three races will be used.

7. Safety

All shall wear a USCG approved PFD at all times on the water or on the dock

8. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers. Additional trophies, if warranted, will be awarded at the discretion of the organization committee.
